

NCRS report on Crime against Women in India

A total of 41,28,248 cases of crimes against women were registered across India in 2021, marking an increase of 15.3 percent from 2020.

Majority of cases under crime against women were registered under 'Crash by Husband or His Relative' (31.8 percent), followed by 'Assault on Women with Intent to outrage his Modesty' (20.8 percent), 'Kidnapping and Abduction of Woman' (17.6 percent), and 'Rape' (5.4%), according to NCRS Report.

What experts say on crime against women

Pooja Khanna, a social activist and director of the Centre for Social Research, said the NCRS data validate that crimes against women increased during the pandemic.

"We need more robust action as the current one collapsed during Covid-19. We need to look at the future and prevent such a situation," she told PTI.

Ujjwala Bhayanna, a women rights activist who heads People Against Rape in India, said Poo Khanna's Medii spoke about respect for women in her Independence Day address and it is high that standard operating procedures and systems that have been put in place get implemented well on the ground.

"Action-oriented steps must take place. Even the Nirbhaya Case took nine years for justice. A strong message against rape has not been again women given yet," Bhayanna said.

IPC 498A - Cruelty by Husband And Relatives

Passed in 1983 to punish dowry demands and marital cruelty to married woman, Section 498A of IPC has instead been known to be one of the most abused sections under Indian Penal Code. For years, the conviction rate of this section has been lower amongst all sections of IPC except petty crimes like theft and hurt. The misuse of this provision has been so much that in 2006, Supreme Court of India compared it to legal Terrorism.

In 2014, Supreme Court delved deep into the issue and passed guidelines for police to follow before making arrests under 498A. In the immediate aftermath of this judgment, the number of 498A cases registered in India went down and the number of arrests in such cases also went down by a good margin. Police was now bound to issue summons to accused to join investigation under CrPc 498 unless before whom they could immediately advise entire families on registration of FIR. This brought some respite to victims of misuse of this section.

IPC 376 - Rape

There were 28,046 rape cases registered in India in 2020. Of these 3,248 were closed by police citing as false and overall 5.0 cases were closed by police either because they were false or there was a mistake of fact on basis of which a charge sheet etc. that 90.1% of rape cases were closed by police for not finding marks on the case. 31,103 men, 1,504 women were arrested under Rape charges last year making total arrests under the section 32,607.

2413 cases were stated in courts of which 5,203 led to acquittal and 2,216 led to conviction making the conviction rate as 29.

Rape cases pending total at the end of 2020 are 151,000 which was 145,565 in 2019. Pending percentage of rape cases in India by end of 2020 is 94.2.

The deeper the criminal law amendment 2019 has taken for rape cases to be stated in fast-track courts and day to day hearings.

Rape on pretext of Marriage

Number of rape cases registered under pretext of marriage by a friend or a 20+ in partner combined with cases filed against separated husband in 2020 are 10,751 which is 38.5% of total reported cases in India. The number was 16,311 out of 32,043 etc 51% of reported rape cases in 2019 and 18,168 out of 31,256 i.e. 58.1% of reported rape cases in 2018.

Rape on pretext of marriage are cases where the man has sexual relationship with a woman illegally on pretext of marriage but later on refuses to get married to her. This information can

NEW DELHI: The National Crime Records Bureau (NCRB)

published the latest report for the year 2021 on August 24. In 2021 there was a 15.3 percent increase in crimes against women compared to the previous year.

Delhi has been named as the most unsafe city for women. A 15,700 cases of crime against women were registered in the city in 2021, which is notably 10 percent higher from that of last year's. The highest is followed by Mumbai and Bangalore. According to NCRB, 1257 incidents of girl child victims of genital offences were recorded under the protection of children from sexual offences Act in 2021. According to the data, the number of girl child rape cases reported in 2021 reached 823, the greatest in 2021 reached while Delhi recorded the highest number of kidnapping cases amongst the metro cities. In 2020 at 5175 as against 2101 in 2020, the cases of murder registered a three fold increase. There has been an upsurge.

The number of cybercrimes in the national capital increased by 11% in 2021 compared to the previous year, with the majority of cases being motivated by sexual exploitation, according to NCRB data. The majority of these had been on upsurge. The majority of the offenders in the over 350 cases of cybercrime had been reported last year.

Students took part in a case study program. The student explained each case study in depth to the teaching, non teaching, office staff and fellow mates. This type of case studies improves their awareness about the cell.
















The convenor of the program has explained about POSH rules. The case study books were handed over to the convenor.
