

### NCRS report on Crime against Women in India

A total of 21,28,278 cases of crime against women were registered across India in 2021, marking an increase of 15.2 percent from 2020.

Majority of cases under crime against women were registered under 'Crucial by Husband or his Relative' (31.8 percent), followed by 'Assault on Women with Intent to outrage her Modesty' (20.7 percent), 'Kidnapping and Abduction of Women' (17.6 percent), and 'Rape' (5.4%), according to NCRS report.

**What reports say on crime against women**

Sanjanna Kumari, a social activist and director of the Centre for Social Research, said the NCRS data validate that crimes against women increased during the pandemic.

"We need more robust system as the current one collapsed during covid-19. We need to look at the future and prevent such a situation," she told PTI.

Ujjwala Bhayanna, a women rights activist who heads People Against Rape in India, said "For slow-motion Modi" spoke about respect for women in his Independence Day address and it is high that standard operating procedures and systems that have been put in place get implemented on the ground.

"Action-oriented steps must take place. Even the Alibhaya case took nine years for justice. A strong message against rape has not been given yet," Bhayanna said.

### IPC 498 - Rape :-

There were 26,046 rape cases registered in India in 2020. Of these 2,200 were closed by police citing as false and over 500 cases were closed by police either because they were false or there was a mistake of fact on law or it was a civil dispute. It is 10% of rape cases were closed by police for not finding facts in the case. 21,143 men, 1,504 women were arrested under Rape charges last year marking total arrests under the section 52,173.

2712 cases were noted in courts of which 5,403 led to acquittal and 2,215 led to conviction making the conviction rate as 20.

Rape cases pending total at the end of 2020 are 157,000 which was 140,565 in 2019. Pending percentage of rape cases in India by end of 2020 is 24.2%.

There despite the criminal law amendment 2013 has nothing for rape case to be stated in fast-track courts and day to day hearings.

### Rape on pretext of Marriage

Number of rape cases registered under pretext of marriage by a father or a son-in-law combined with cases filed against separated husband in 2020 are 10,451 which is 26% of all rape reported cases in India. This number was 10,711 out of 22,043 i.e. 48% of reported rape cases in 2019 and 12,608 out of 21,282 i.e. 59% of reported rape cases in 2018.

Rape on pretext of marriage are cases where the man has sexual intercourse with a woman allegedly on pretext of marriage but later on refuses to get married to her. This information was

### IPC 498A - Cruelty by Husband And Relatives


Passed in 1983 to punish dowry demands and prevent cruelty to married women, Section 498A of IPC has instead been known to be one of the most abused sections under Indian Penal Code. For years the conviction rate of this section has been lower amongst all sections of IPC except being aimed like theft and hurt. The misuse of this provision has been so much that in 2009, Supreme Court of India compared it to legal Terrorism.

In 2011, Supreme Court delved deep into the issue and passed guidelines for police to follow before making arrests under this section. In the landmark aftermath of this judgment called the Binayati Woman judgment, the number of 498A cases registered in India went down and the number of arrests in such cases also went down by a good margin. Police was then bound to issue summons in arrests to join investigations under CrPc 209 unless before where they could immediately arrest entire families on registration of FIR. This brought some respect to victims of misuse of this section.

### NEW DELHI: The National Crime Research Bureau (NCRB)

published the latest report for the year 2021 on August 04. In 2021 NCRB saw a 15.3 percent increase in crimes against women compared to the previous year.

Bellary has been named as the most unsafe city for women. At 15,890 cases of crime against women were registered in the city in 2021, which is notably 10 percent higher from that of last year's. The districts followed by Mumbai and Bangalore. According to NCRB, 127 incidents of girl child victims of sexual offences were recorded under the protection of children from sexual offences Act in 2021. According to the data, the number of girl child rape cases reported in 2021 numbered 823. The greatest increase reached while Bellary recorded the highest number of kidnapping cases amongst the metro cities. In 2020, 5175 cases against 21,071 in 2020, the cases of murder registered a three fold increase. The number of cybercrimes in the national capital increased by 10% in 2021 compared to the previous year, with the majority of cases being motivated by sexual exploitation, according to NCRB data. The majority of these had been on cybersex. The majority of the offenders on the over 300 cases were of cybersex had been reported last year.

The convenor of the program has explained about POSH rules. The case study books were handed over to the convenor.
















