# Report on 73<sup>rd</sup> Republic Day celebration

## In our college

India got freedom on 15<sup>th</sup> of August, 1947 and became a Republic country on 26<sup>th</sup> of January, 1950. The new constitution of free India came into force with effect from this day.

We celebrated the **73<sup>rd</sup> Republic day** with patriotic favour at the college campus of **Sree Siddaganga college of Arts Science and Commerce for Women**, Tumkur, Karnataka. The NCC cadets, all our students and teachers were assembled by 7:30 AM at college campus with great joy to celebrate the day.



The NCC cadets were wearing the perfect, neat uniform with ceremonials. They were all lined up by setting their berets, their red hackles were seen like roses. They were looking forward with joy to start the program.

The program started at 7.45AM with the arrival of our chief guest **Mr. L. Narasimhaiah Tondhati**. He was escorted by our principal **Dr K C Jayaswamy**, **Sri Mallesh Babu S**, CTO NCC and **Prof G Chidanandamurthy**, IQAC Co-ordinator.





All the dignitaries came up on the dais. The NCC piloting cadets were came to the dais, salute to the guest and requesting him to hoist the flag.

The guest came to the flag area and commemorated the flag hoisting event. It was followed by National salute and National Anthem.



As soon as national anthem completed, the NCC cadets performed March past commanded by our Cadet Senior under Officer **Vijay kumara S** after taking the permission of the chief guest.

The Program anchor **Smt. Shwetha C S** Lecturer, Dept of Kannada, saying that it was a proud moment for her to be a anchor of that auspicious occasion, She started up with some inspiring lines about our country and also about the importance of Republic day.

The program was started with welcome speech by **Prof Vishwanand**, Physical director. He welcomed all the dignitaries who were presented in that occasion and also welcomed the teaching, non-teaching staff, NCC Cadets and also students who presented in the national festival celebration.



After Welcome speech, the students from 1<sup>st</sup> year BSc, **Kumari. Samanvitha N V** and **Kumari Ashwini H P** delivered their speeches about Republic day.

The Republic day speech delivered by **Dr.J Narendra**, Head, Department of English where he gave a brief speech on our constitution and how it came into existence. He said “Republic Day commemorates the spirit of independent India. Although our constitution was formed on 26<sup>th</sup> November 1949, it came into being from



26<sup>th</sup> January 1950 because it was on this day in 1930 the Indian National Congress proclaimed Poorna swaraj from British rule. He said, “it is our responsibility to follow the duties given by our constitution before availing the rights given by it”. It was really a motivational and knowledgeable speech.



After the speech, **Smt Harshashree R**, Lecturer, Dept of Commerce gave the introduction of the chief guest **L Narasimhaiah Tandoti**

Then our chief guest **L Narasimhaiah Tandohatti** came on the dais to share few words where he shared about his early life and his struggles in the period of british government. He inspired and motivated all the youthful cadets and also the students. He said that “we should be ready to make every sacrifice to protect our country”.



**Lt. Dr JayaPrakash and Surinder Singh** visited to our college campus from the 4KAR BN on that day to look over the celebration of the national festival.

The program concluded with a vote of thanks proposed by **Prof G Chidanandhamurthy**, IQAC Co-ordinator, SSCASCW, Tumkur.



Sweets were distributed to all the students, faculty members and cadets at the end of Program. It was followed by refreshments.
